First and foremost, thank you for all you are doing to ensure an equitable and expedient distribution of COVD-19 vaccine in Minnesotans. We appreciate the opportunity to provide input as you review federal guidance and make recommendations on vaccine rollout in Minnesota.

The health and safety of customers and employees of Minnesota's retailers are a top priority for the Minnesota Retailers Association.
